

BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE MIDDLESEX COUNTY COLLEGE

Minutes of the Meeting of February 27, 2008

A regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of Middlesex County College was held at 7:15 p.m. in the Corral in the College Center. Members present were: Mmes. Palumbo and Wesnowsky. Messrs. Antisell, Bauer, Finkelstein, Raja, Rivas, Sica and Tighe. Mrs. Power and Messrs. Mulkerin and Piegari were absent. Also present were President La Perla-Morales, Mr. Pulomena, Mr. Hoffman, Mr. Lazaro, Ms. D'Aloisio and several staff members.

In compliance with the "Open Public Meetings Act" of the State of New Jersey, adequate notice of this meeting was provided as follows:

Vice Chairman Tighe opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

ACADEMIC, STUDENT AND ALUMNI AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

- a. The Board approves the proposal for the operation of a project entitled CENTER ENHANCEMENT PROJECT, as submitted by the College to the State of New Jersey, Commission on Higher Education, for the period January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2008, in the total amount of \$25,000.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees authorized participation in the NJEDge.Net Joint Purchasing Consortium; and

WHEREAS, the Consortium currently requires telecommunication services; and

WHEREAS, NJEDge.Net advertised for Proposal #638 and received responses for the participating institutions of Higher Education in the Consortium; and

WHEREAS, Broadview Networks, Inc., Melville, NY was the winning service provider;

FINANCE COMMITTEE

Mr. Finkelstein moved, seconded by Mr. Bauer, for adoption of resolutions 1 – 5:

1. WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that \$70,893,865 is the amount necessary for the Current Unrestricted Fund and \$2,000,000 is the amount necessary for the Minor Capital Fund for the fiscal year July 1, 2008 to June 30, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees held a public hearing to review said budget on February 13, 2008,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:

- a. The budget for the fiscal year July 1, 2008 to June 30, 2009 in the amount of \$70,893,865 for Current Unrestricted Operations and \$2,000,000 for Minor Capital be approved; and
 - b. The Assistant Secretary of the Board of Trustees be, and she is hereby, instructed to forward a copy of said budget to each of the members of the Board of School Estimate; and
 - c. A public hearing by the Board of School Estimate with respect to the amount of money estimated to be necessary for Current Unrestricted Fund and Minor Capital Fund for the fiscal year July 1, 2008 to June 30, 2009 shall be held on Thursday, March 20, 2008 at 6:30 PM in the Freeholders Meeting Room, County Administration Building, New Brunswick, New Jersey; and
 - d. The Vice President for Finance and Administration be, and she is hereby, instructed to publish in the Home News Tribune, East Brunswick, NJ, at least seven (7) days prior to the date fixed for the public hearing and also set forth an itemized statement as to the amount of money which the Board of Trustees has determined to be necessary for the Current Unrestricted Fund for the Fiscal Year July 1, 2008 to June 30, 2009, which notice shall also indicate that said itemized statement will be on file and open to examination by the public between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, at the Office of the Vice President for Finance and Administration at Middlesex County College, Edison, NJ, from the date of publication to the date of the public hearing.
2. WHEREAS, the President has recommended an increase in the tuition rates, for academic sessions scheduled for FY2009, including pre-summer session FY2008, in order to provide a portion of the revenue resource for the services to be rendered; and
- WHEREAS, the President has developed a Current Unrestricted Fund to provide educational and other services to the students of Middlesex County College for the year July 1, 2008 to June 30, 2009; and
- WHEREAS, said services are funded by students, the State of New Jersey and the County of Middlesex; and
- WHEREAS, as required by the Higher Education Restructuring Act of 1994 a public hearing was held on February 13, 2008,
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the following changes in credit hour tuition rates, be approved commencing with the sessions scheduled for FY2009, including pre-summer session FY2008 as follows:

- a. In-county tuition credit hour rate be increased from \$85.55 per credit hour to \$91.00 per credit hour; and
 - b. Out-of-county tuition credit hour rate be increased from \$171.10 per credit hour to \$182.00 per credit hour; and
 - c. Out-of-state tuition credit hour rate be increased from \$171.10 per credit hour to \$182.00 per credit hour.
3. WHEREAS, the President recommends an increase in the technology fee from \$9.50 to \$11.00 per credit hour in-county and \$19.00 to \$22.00 per credit hour out-of-county and out-of-state, an increase in the general fee from \$14.50 to \$16.00 per credit hour for in-county and from \$29.00 to \$32.00 per credit hour for out-of-county and out-of-state for academic sessions scheduled for FY 2009 including the pre-summer session FY 2008 in order to provide a portion of the revenue source for the services to be rendered; and

WHEREAS, as required by the Higher Education Restructuring Act of 1994 a public hearing on these fee increases was held on February 13, 2008,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that these fee changes be approved as listed.

4. BE IT RESOLVED that the invoice for professional services rendered by the firm of Wilentz, Goldman & Spitzer for the period October 1, 2007 through and including December 31, 2007 be approved for payment in the amount of \$14,616.16
