

BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF MIDDLESEX COUNTY COLLEGE

Minutes of the Meeting of September 29, 2010

The rescheduled meeting of the Board of Trustees of Middlesex County College was held at 9:09 a.m. in the Boardroom of Chambers Hall, located on the College campus. Members present were: Mmes. Brosnan-Barth and Power, and Messrs. Antisell, Bauer, Finkelstein, Lisicki, Mulkerin, Piegari, and Sica. Ms. Palumbo and Messrs. Raja and Tighe were absent. Also present were President La Perla-Morales, Mr. Hoffman, Ms. D'Aloisio and several staff members.

In compliance with the "Open Public Meetings Act" of the State of New Jersey, adequate notice of this meeting was provided as follows:

ACADEMIC, STUDENT, ALUMNI AND MINORITY AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

Mr. Finkelstein moved, seconded by Mr. Sica, for adoption of resolutions 1 and 2:

1. WHEREAS, an application entitled PROJECT SPAN/HSAC has been submitted by the College to the Middlesex County Department of Human Services (hereinafter referred to as the "County") in the amount of \$20,000; and

WHEREAS, the County has approved the application entitled PROJECT SPAN/HSAC as submitted by the College; and

WHEREAS, R.S. 18A: 64A-12J grants the Board the power to enter into contracts which it deems necessary and advisable with the State of New Jersey or any of its political subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that the operation of a project entitled, PROJECT SPAN/HSAC is consistent with the philosophy and purpose of the College,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:
 - a. The Board approves the application for the project entitled, PROJECT SPAN/HSAC as submitted by the College to the Middlesex County Department of Human Services for the period January 1, 2011 through December 31, 2011, in the total amount of \$20,000.
 - b. The Board herein accepts the award of \$20,000 and authorizes the College President and/or her designee to implement the project.
