

BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF MIDDLESEX COUNTY COLLEGE

Minutes of the Meeting of September 28, 2011

The scheduled meeting of the Board of Trustees of Middlesex County College was held at 9:02 a.m. in the Boardroom of Chambers Hall, located on the College campus. Members present were: Mmes. Manzoor, Palumbo and Power and Messrs. Bauer, Finkelstein, Raja, Sica and Tighe. Messrs. Antisell, Lisicki, Mulkerin and Stewart were absent. Also present were President La Perla-Morales, Mr. Golum, Ms. D'Aloisio and several staff members.
