



- Books and monographs. The items in our catalog are already in this bibliography. Authors with new books or monographs are encouraged to donate a copy to the physical library collection if they have not already.
- **Book chapters** or **journal articles.** In some fields, these are typical outputs. We will include the citation, but not a citation to the book/journal in which it was published. Single journal issues that contain MCC-faculty/staff authored articles will not be added to our physical library collection, with the exception of *Middlesex: A Literary Journal*.
- Solo and group art exhibitions/shows/appearances.
- Translated texts and edited works.
- Doctoral dissertations.
