Minutes of the Meeting of March 14, 2012

The scheduled meeting of the Board of Trustees of Middlesex County College was held at 9:00 a.m. in the Boardroom of Chambers Hall, located on the College campus. Members present were: Mmes. Manzoor, Palumbo and Power and Messrs. Bauer, Finkelstein, Sica, Stewart and Tighe. Messrs. Antisell, Lisicki, Mulkerin, and Raja were absent. Also present were President La Perla-Morales, Freeholder Tomaro, Mr. Hoffman, and Ms. D'Aloisio and several staff members.

In compliance with the "Open Public Meetings Act" of the State of New Jersey, adequate notice of this meeting was provided as follows:

Chairman Power led the Pledge of Allegiance.

ACADEMIC, STUDENT, ALUMNI AND MINORITY AFFAIRS COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, Lot 2, LLC and Middlesex County College ("MCC") have executed a Power Purchase Agreement for the sale of solar generated electricity, dated June 30, 2011 (the "Lot 2 PPA"), pursuant to which Lot 2 agreed to finance, install, own, operate and maintain a solar energy facility on MCC's car park known as "Parking Lot 2";

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WHEREAS, Lot 6, LLC and MCC have executed a Power Purchase Agreement for the sale of solar generated electricity, dated June 30, 2011 (the "Lot 6 PPA"), pursuant to which Lot 6 agreed to finance, install, own, operate and maintain a solar energy facility on MCC's car park known as "Parking Lot 6";

WHEREAS, the Lot 2 PPA and the Lot 6 PPA provide that if the Solar Alternative Compliance Payment ("SACP") Schedule is reduced below a certain level, Lot 2 LLC and Lot 6 LLC may terminate the Lot 2 PPA and the Lot 6 PPA;

WHEREAS, in anticipation of a change in the SACP Schedule Lot 2 LLC and Lot 6 LLC and in anticipation of exercising its option to terminate the Lot 2 PPA and the Lot 6, PPA, Lot 2 LLC and Lot 6 LLC have not commenced the governmental approval process for the Lot 2 PPA and the Lot 6 PPA; and

WHEREAS, based on the above, the MCC and Lot 2, LLC and Lot 6, LLC have agreed to a settlement of the Lot 2 PPA and Lot 6 PPA, whereby Lot 2, LLC and Lot 6, LLC have agreed to reimburse MCC in the amount of \$150,000.00, for expenses incurred by MCC.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved as follows:

- a. MCC agrees that the Lot 2 PPA and Lot 6 PPA be terminated pursuant to a Termination Agreement substantially in the form attached hereto.
- b. MCC agrees to grant Vanguard Energy Partners ("VEP") an option exercisable by no later than May, 1, 2013, to finance, install, own, operate and maintain a solar energy facility on Parking Lot 2 and/or Parking Lot 6 in accordance with the terms of an Option Agreement between MCC and VEP, substantially in the form attached hereto.
- c. The Board of Trustees authorizes the President of the College to execute the Termination Agreement and Option Agreement substantially in the form attached hereto.
