Also present were President La Perla-Morales, Mr. Hoffman, Ms. D'Aloisio and several staff members.

### REPORT OF THE PRESIDENT

Dr. La Perla-Morales reported that four of our STEM students received fellowships through the Rutgers University, New Jersey Space Grant Consortium. Middlesex was one of six community colleges selected by Rutgers to participate in the consortium. Three of the colleges were not able to meet the requirements and of the remaining three only two have been able to completely meet the requirements. Each of the four students selected to be our fellows will receive a total of \$5,000 to participate in the research. On December 14, three of the students presented their research to an audience of faculty, staff and students. In attendance was Dr. Haim Baruh, Professor of Mechanical and Aerospace Engineering and Director of the NJ Space Grant Consortium. After the presentations we discussed the project and he indicated that Middlesex had the best students and an outstanding faculty. He is so impressed that he will most likely re-allocate funds from the non-

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performing institutions to Middlesex. A great deal of credit should be given to Professors Rowley, Levy, Associate Chairperson Phalguni Ghosh, and Chair Parag Muley.
