The Library is currently working on the second MCC Scholarly and Creative Works Bibliography and welcomes you to contribute! As you might remember, last year the Library published the first annual MCC bibliography to acknowledge the scholarly and creative output of Middlesex County College faculty and staff. We also held a spring reception, with a keynote by Shirley Wachtel, to honor those who submitted to the bibliography.

Submissions.

For this year, we welcome all authors, researchers, artists, editors, and other creators to provide us with information about the work you've produced. Further, you will soon receive a message from CELT, requesting information on your other accomplishments and presentations; together we aim to collect information on all of your accomplishments so that as a community we can share in and celebrate them.

Monograph items currently in our library collection are in Volume 1, so you do not need to submit a form for it. If you published a monograph that we do not own, please consider completing a form and/or donating a copy to the Library.

Bibliography and Reception.

The MCC Scholarly and Creative Works Bibliography will be added to our MCC digital collections (<http://digital.middlesexcc.edu/celebratingmcc>) and will be linked from the CELT page. The printed bibliography will be housed in the physical College Archive and be available at the spring MCC Works reception, jointly sponsored by the Library and CELT. The reception, slated for March 31, 2020 at 2 PM in IRC 235, will celebrate published works and professional accomplishments. This is a separate event from the annual MCC Faculty Awards event.

Other Writing/Engagement Opportunities.

On a related note, the Library is looking for authors/creative types to be photographed with their works for a MCC Writes/Creates poster. In addition, if you would like guidance for scholarly or creative works that you are in the process of writing and publishing, the Library Services Department holds a weekly writing circle for faculty and staff to discuss writing and to write on Tuesdays in IRC 228.
