Subject: President's Report - February, 1999

On February 18, Don Wernik, Howard Bellizio and I attended the first meeting of the New Jersey Council of County College's Trustee Ambassadors held at the State House in Trenton. The central purpose of the Council's newly initiated Ambassador Program is to enhance communication between the executive and legislative branches of State government and the trustees of New Jersey's 19 community colleges. So that morning trustees and community college presidents from across the State met with legislators and representatives of the New Jersey Department of the Treasury to exchange views and information. All in all it was an auspicious beginning for this new program which, it is hoped, will build on the success of the Committee to Reinvest in New Jersey's Community Colleges.

Our preparations for the Spring, 2000 visit by an evaluation team representing the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools continues. After consultation with Dr. George Santiago, Executive Associate Director of MSA, we agreed with the appointment of Dr. Edna Baehre as team chairperson. Dr. Baehre currently serves as president of Harrisburg Area Community College. Prior to that appointment, she was the vice president for academic affairs at a community college in Illinois. I had a pleasant telephone conversation with Dr. Baehre and we tentatively agreed on April 9, 10, 11 and 12,2000 as the dates for the team visit. Dr. Baehre will make a preliminary campus visit either later this Spring or early next Fall.

Recently I accepted an invitation to serve on a Community Advisory Committee to the Woodbridge School System in connection with a major grant proposal they are preparing. The initial meeting of the committee was held on February 9. After the meeting I had a conversation with Jeff Graber, Assistant Superintendent, who was extremely complimentary of the programs and services they have received from the College over the past few years. Under the auspices of our Office of School Relations we have been fostering collaborative efforts with the local school systems, including teacher training and curriculum development. And, as you may recall, the Woodbridge System is a partner in NJCATE, and Dr. Graber is an enthusiastic proponent of the Mecomtronics
program. With the success of "block scheduling" introduced a year ago at Colonia High School and the additional educational opportunities that form of scheduling permits, Dr. Graber indicated that he and Dr. Seitz, Superintendent of Schools in Woodbridge, wish to explore the possibility of our offering selected college level courses to the Colonia students. Specifically he mentioned an introductory Mecomtronics course.

Finally, let me note that the Finance Committee of the Council of County Colleges, which I chair, met here on February 19. The meeting focused on the implementation of "performance funding" for FY 2000. Under the Governor's performance funding proposal, $1 \%$ of our State funding next year (for MCC approximately $\$ 100,000$ ) will depend on our "scores" on a variety of measures related to student success and the College's ability to establish collaborative relationships which will provide our students and graduates with additional opportunities. Unfortunately, as a consequence of staff changes both in the executive branch and the Commission on Higher Education, the performance criteria are not yet finalized. Additional meetings with representatives of the Treasury Department and the Commission will be scheduled in an effort to finalize the details. As chair of the Finance Committee I will be at those meetings and will bring you up to date $-I$ hope at next month's meeting.
